About our Website

Vintage is a global venture platform invested in leading venture funds and startups. We are a portal to a global network of tech companies across Israel, Europe, and the U.S. The Website provides you with information about some of our business activities, blogs, and contact details (the “Services”).

What Types of Personal Information Do We Collect and Why?

We use personal information related to you to provide, manage and enhance our Website and Services. These purposes include, for example:

- Addressing your requests and maintaining contact with you;
- Improving the Website and the Services, including by establishing statistical data about our web traffic;
- Preventing harm to the Website and Services, including by identifying and handling abusive activities, preventing cyber-attacks, fraud, identity theft and any other unlawful or unauthorized use of the Website and Services;
- For legal action and defense and in any other matter that requires the use of personal information related to you under applicable laws, rules and regulations.

You are not legally obligated to provide us with any personal information related to you.

When you contact us via the [Contact Us](#) or [Let’s Talk](#) web pages, we will request your full name and email address. Your message to us through these web pages can include additional personal information related to you. Please do not provide us unnecessary personal information, and especially avoid sharing with us any personal information related to others without their proper consent.

When you log-in through [LP Login](#), which provides you with access to the data room that we offer you to use, you will need to fill-in your log-in details.

You can subscribe to our blog, through the [Content](#) web page. We will request your name and email address to subscribe, to send you our blog posts and other materials, including business, marketing and promotional content.

We also collect traffic data that users’ online activities generate such as IP addresses, browser information, session durations and viewed pages.

Your interaction with other websites, social media features and widgets, through the Website, is governed by the privacy policies of the owners and operators of these online services. We are not responsible for any use, misuse, or unlawful use of the personal information that you choose to post or share on or through these services.

We use Google Analytics. Google Analytics collects website usage information which may include personal information. Please read Google Analytics' privacy policy [here](#).

We process aggregated data that is not personally identifiable information. For example, we use statistical non-identifying analysis data to improve the Website and Services.

How do we Share your Personal Information?

We do not sell, rent or lease personal information related to you. We will share such information with service providers and other third parties, as necessary to fulfill the purposes for collecting the information. For example, we use service providers to manage the transmission of our email messages, to host the Website's files and data and to provide us with usage analytics.

We will also share personal information related to you with our affiliates. These include companies and partnerships within our global group.

We will report any content that you upload and share user personally identifiable information, if we believe that such content is illegal or abusive or may violate any third-party rights.

A merger, acquisition or any other structural change will require us to transfer personal information related to you to another entity, provided that the receiving entity will comply with this policy.

We share non-identifying statistical and aggregated data with our partners, clients and affiliates.

How Can You Access and Modify Personal Information Related to You?

If you find that personal information related to you is inaccurate, incomplete, or not up to date, please provide us the necessary information to correct it.

You can contact us through the Website's contact-us page at: <https://www.vintage-ip.com/contact/> and request access to the personal information that we keep about you. If needed, we will ask you to provide us with certain credentials or details to make sure that you are who you claim to be.

You can also request to correct any inaccurate details about you or delete them. We will consider your request in accordance with laws and regulations that apply to you. Note that we can delete personal information related to you in different manners, including by removing identifying information and transforming personal information that relates to you into anonymized data.

For How Long Do We Keep Personal Information Related to You?

We keep personal information related to you for as necessary for the purposes for which such personal information that relates to you is processed, unless otherwise required under applicable law.

If we retain personal information related to you for any legitimate business purpose other than to provide the Services or operate the Website, we will make efforts to limit the access to personal information related to you and the retention time to a minimum.

Note that we can keep aggregated non-identifiable data without limitation, and to the extent reasonable we will delete or de-identify potentially identifiable information, when we no longer need to process the data in an identifiable form.

How Do We Keep Personal Information Related to You Secured?

We implement information security measures, including internal policies and procedures, to secure personal information related to you and to minimize the risks of theft, damage, loss of data, or unauthorized access.

These measures provide sound industry-standard security protection. However, although we make efforts to protect your privacy, we cannot guarantee that the Website or the Services will be immune from any wrongdoings, malfunctions, unlawful access, or other kinds of abuse and misuse.

Where Do We Store and Process Personal Information Related to You?

We store and process personal information related to you in the United States and Israel, including sites operated and maintained by cloud-based hosting service providers in the U.S.

We take measures to ensure that transfer of personal information to other territories is made in a secure manner and in compliance with applicable laws. Your use of the Website signifies your acknowledgement and approval for such data transfer.

What Are Cookies and When Do We Use Them?

Cookies are small files that a web server sends to a user's device, when the user browses online. Your device removes session cookies when you close your browser session. Persistent cookies last for longer periods. You can view the expiry date of each cookie, through your browser settings. We use both types to manage and enhance the Website navigation, analyze its use, and assist in our marketing efforts.

Every browser allows you to manage your cookies preferences. You can block or remove certain or all cookies, through your browser settings. Please bear in mind that blocking or removing cookies can impact your user experience with the Services. How we Change This Privacy Policy?

We can update our privacy policy from time to time after giving proper notice. If the updates have minor if any consequences, they will take effect 7 days after we post a notice on the Website or send an email message to you. If the updates have substantial consequences, they will take effect 30 days after we post a notice on the Website or send an email message to you.

Until the new policy takes effect, you can choose not to accept it and terminate your use of the Website. If you continue your use of the Website after the new policy takes effect, it will express your agreement to the new privacy policy. Note that if we need to adapt the policy to legal requirements, the new policy will become effective immediately or as required by law.

This privacy policy was updated on February 27, 2020.
